

Undergraduate student position in the Laboratory of Bioorganic Chemistry

Two undergraduate student positions with full-stipend funded by a grant from the National Centre of Science (Poland; OPUS program) coordinated by dr hab. Joanna Kowalska, are available from November 2020 in The Laboratory of Bioorganic Chemistry at the Faculty of Physics, University of Warsaw.

Candidates profile:

We seek motivated candidates with a BSc degree in chemistry, biology, physics or related field. The successful candidate should hold active MSc student status. Knowledge of molecular biology and nucleotides synthesis methods, as well as experience in the synthesis of nucleotides and their analogues and work with RNA will be appreciated.

Job duties:

Chosen candidates will conduct research on the characterization of fluorescently labeled molecular probes and their interactions with recombinant cap degradation enzymes. The research will be carried out using biophysical, spectroscopic and microscopic methods as well as using molecular biology techniques (expression of recombinant proteins, transcription).

Employment conditions:

- stipend/scholarship
- total gross scholarship per month: 1000 PLN
- employment period: 9 months (position 1), 18 months (position 2)

Required documents:

- CV including a description of prior research experience
- cover letter with information on the processing of personal data - information and consent clauses (form attached to the announcement) In case of an e-mail application in PDF format, it should contain a scanned signature
- list of publications, conference presentations and other achievements
- transcript of record from undergraduate studies (I degree)
- copy of obtained diploma
- contact details (phone numbers and e-mails) for previous research supervisor or other research associates
